Traditional Food

At midday, a type of porridge is eaten made from a type of corn called Frumenty; it can be eaten before then.

At dinner, roasted turkey, sprouts, toffee pudding, plum pudding, mince pies, orange marmalade cake, chocolate Yule log, sauces like cranberry sauce and Cumberland sauce, trifle, Wassail, which is an ale based drink seasoned with spices and honey and passed around the table in a bowl which symbolizes the passing of good wishes. Wassail has been associated with Christmas since the 1400's. That are a few dishes that make up the English dinner table.



Trifle Recipe

Ingredients

2 (3 oz.) raspberry jello, partially set

1 angel food cake

Nuts

3 (3 oz.) vanilla pudding, cooked or instant

3-4 bananas

Whipping cream

Recipe

Arrange in layers, in the order given:

Angel food cake, broken in bite-sized pieces

Raspberry jello

Vanilla pudding and bananas

Whipping cream

Angel food cake

Raspberry jello

Nuts

Use a large bowl about the size of a punch bowl. Chill until set.

In England, bad kids get _____ for Christmas. (I couldn't find anything on what bad kids get for Christmas in England.)

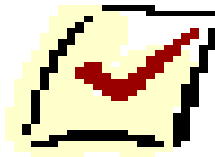




Unique Things About Christmas In England

3. Hanging Stockings

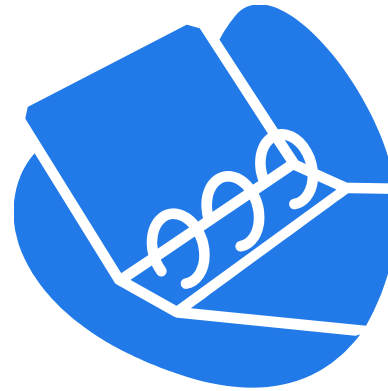


- In England, they hang their stockings all over the house for Father Christmas to fill.
