The decorations in Lebanon are white to convey the hope of peace in their land.





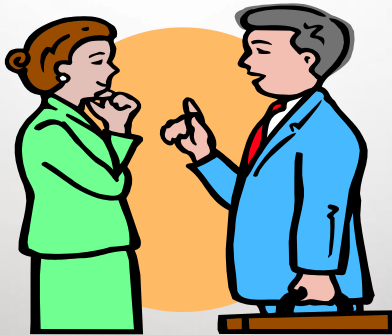
TRADITIONS

14 days before Christmas, the dwellers sow seeds such as chickpeas, sprouts, grains, and beans on cotton wool and not soil. They do this so that, by the time Christmas arrives, there would already be a small bud. These plants are watered regularly for these 14 days and by Christmas, the plants/shoots would already be 6 inches in length. People use these shrubberies to decorate Christmas trees and the Nativity cribs, to mark the birth of the Lord. Here, the characters of the Nativity scenes are made with brow paper and other fineries.

HAM AND SWISS NOODLE BAKE

❖ Prepare noodles according to package directions: drain. In medium skillet, melt butter. Add onion; cook until tender. Blend in soup and sour cream. Add noodles, soup mixture, ham, cheese and onion mixture; mix well. Pour into lightly buttered 9-inch square baking dish. Cover. Bake in a 350 degree oven until hot, about 35 minutes. Uncover. Top with fried onions. Bake 5 minutes longer. You can Refrigerate leftovers.
